Did you know that Habitat Choptank also repairs homes?

Our Home Repair Program partners with low-income homeowners who need help to maintain and perform necessary repairs on their homes, allowing them to reclaim their homes with pride and dignity.

Families eligible for the Home Repair Program make 80% or less than the area median income, own their own home, and have resided in their home as their primary residence for at least one year. The cost of repair is calculated on an income-based sliding scale, and repaid at 0% interest, making home repair affordable.

The repair program helps revitalize the appearance of the neighborhood, strengthen connections within the community, and helps preserve affordable housing stock. Repair program services may include:

- exterior painting
- weatherization
- roof repairs
- accessibility improvements
- other critical health and safety home repairs
