Volunteer Support

As you may have heard, Habitat volunteers with 100 hours or more of service this past year have been hard at work on our job sites and in our ReStore. We wish we could open this up to new volunteers or those with fewer hours, but at this time we need to carefully follow the guidance established by Habitat for Humanity International.

If you are new to Habitat Choptank or don't quite have the 100 hours of service, and would still like to volunteer, the opportunity to do so from your own home is available. Our ReStore will provide items from their inventory

to be repurposed or upcycled. This could involve sanding and staining, painting, reframing, or completely transforming an item. It really is up to you and your creativity, interests and talents. Items then would be resold in our ReStore or during a future auction, helping to generate more funds that are allocated back into our mission. ReStore Operations

Please be advised that ReStore hours have changed temporarily. At least for the month of August, we will be open Tuesday through Friday from noon to 6pm and closed on Saturday. This is to ensure that our staff and volunteers remain as safe as possible, that we can adequately provide the level of customer service needed, and to ensure that we have the ability to replenish merchandise in our newly expanded store. This is temporary and we hope to return to normal Saturday hours in the future. We will keep everyone apprised of future changes.

We are grateful to those in the community who continue to donate and shop in our ReStore to support the need for quality affordable housing in Dorchester & Talbot Counties. **Remember**, **ReStore donation drop-offs** and pick-ups <u>must</u> be scheduled in advance by calling the **ReStore at** 410-820-6186.
