COVID-19 NEXT STEPS

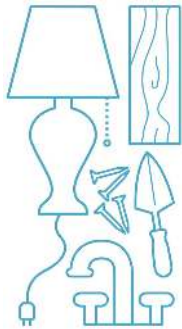
We hope you'll join us in welcoming our new ReStore Manager, Max Pedemonte!
