Tithe Partner - Haiti

Habitat for Humanity's tithe program allows U.S. affiliates to partner with international organizations and contribute a portion of their earnings to help combat the affordable housing crisis worldwide.

Haiti, an impoverished country where nearly 6 in 10 Haitians live in poverty as of 2020, continues to struggle since the destruction of 580,000 houses due to major disasters.

In 1984, Habitat for Humanity began working with Haiti and has served over 70,000 families through a variety of housing solutions. One specific initiative they are focusing on is their 100% Women Build program, allowing opportunity for more women to enter into the construction labor force and make a direct impact to their local community.

Current political situations resulting in increased gang violence have presented challenges for the organization and the surrounding area. Making appropriate adjustments to the workplace to maintain safety and security, the organization continues on with their commitment to the mission.
