Affordability is key to the Habitat model, guaranteeing homebuyers or homeowners will not spend more than 30% of their gross income on housing. In return, families can cover housing costs and still manage the necessities of food, health care, transportation, and education.

A **decent home** means a high quality, low maintenance, and energy-efficient home, one that is secure and less costly to maintain over time.
